Q: I would like to know more about the NDP, where can I find this information ?

A: Follow the link at www.reptonvillage.org.uk

Q: Can I be kept informed of progress with the NDP and other issues / activities in the Parish by e-mail?

A: Yes you can do this by sending an e-mail to np@reptonvillage.org.uk by doing this, you will be entered into the prize draw.

Q: If I need more questionnaires how can I obtain them ?

A: You can download them from the link at www.reptonvillage.org.uk or obtain them at drop in events and Repton Post Office.

Q: Can I fill the questionnaire in on-line?

A: Yes you can. To do this follow the link at www.reptonvillage.org.uk

Q: Can more than one person fill in the questionnaire?

A: Anyone can fill it in, however, only those over 18 will be eligible to vote. The more responses and age ranges we get the better informed the NDP will be.

Q: Can I drop the completed questionnaire off in Milton and Repton?

A: Yes at The Swan in Milton, Redshaws Butchers, The Post Office and Mulberry Beauty Salon in Repton or at a drop in event.

Q: Can I post the completed questionnaire ?

A: Yes in the supplied reply paid envelope. Drop it in any post box. Postage is FREE.

Q: Is the information supplied anonymous?

A: Yes.

Q: Can I speak to someone about the questionnaire or discuss matters of concern ?

A: Yes at drop in events: 2 to be held in Repton Village Hall and 1 in Milton Village Hall during the month of October.

Q: Can I add comments / observations?

A: There are spaces for this. Alternatively send us an e-mail (this will not be anonymous) or continue on a plain sheet of paper

Q: When does the questionnaire have to be returned by?

A: October 31st 2015

Q: Will there be other opportunities to comment.

A: Yes initially at the October drop in events and at others to be scheduled as results from the survey are collated.

Q: Will the findings be communicated?

A: Suggested policies will be put forward at further drop in events. A "draft" NDP will also be made available for comment.

Q: What happens if I do not like what is in the NDP?

A: Before the NDP is adopted there will be a referendum run by SDDC. It will be a simple Yes / No vote.
