CEF 12 LIST OF ISSUES RAISED AT PARISH COUNCIL MEETINGS

In general the issues most commonly raised are in no particular order:

- 1) Development / comments on planning matters.
- 2) Speeding traffic.
- 3) Parking issues.
- 4) Play Facilities

Issues raised at Parish Council meetings usually take four forms:

- a) Written representations are included as Agenda items and made available to all members of the Parish Council. If deemed necessary the matters raised are discussed otherwise the comments are noted
- b) Informal representation to Councillors that can be raised during a normal PC meeting and either discussed at that stage or added to future agenda.
- c) E-mail representations to the Clerk are dealt with in the same way as 1) above.
- d) Telephone conversations are logged and are raised if considered appropriate during the Clerks Report.

Any representations to the Parish Council will therefore be recorded within the minutes of the relevant meeting.
